

Waterton Lane, Mossley. Supported accommodation for singles/ couples or families.

Westbrook, Stalybridge. This service for homeless single women aged 16-60. The service can accommodate up to three women with babies up to 12 months old.

Wickham House, Ashton is for single men aged over 18 with mental health needs.

Wish, Hyde. Supported self catering accommodation for up to 11 women with 4 move-on flats. The above scheme is intended to prepare single females aged 16-59 to move.

Leaflet Seven

If you have nowhere to stay whilst your reasons for homelessness are checked out, we may provide temporary/supported accommodation for you. Please be aware we can only offer you accommodation on the day you become homeless.

We will always try to accommodate you in Tameside, but where this is not possible you would be placed out of the borough. Unfortunately you will not get a choice in what accommodation is offered to you, and pets are not allowed.

Temporary Accommodation,

Bed and Breakfasts are used when there is no suitable alternative and for the shortest period of time possible, we will move you to supported accommodation when a suitable vacancy arises. Moves can happen at very short notice.

Supported Accommodation,

The council has access to a range of specialist supported accommodation within the borough for single people and families and many agencies work together to ensure that all accommodation is of a good standard.

Whilst in supported accommodation you will be advised on what steps you need to take to prepare yourself for securing permanent accommodation.

These steps include;

- entering into a repayment plan to address any former tenant arrears you may have.
- participation in any programme you are on to address any issues you may have e.g drug or alcohol problems.
- abide by the terms and conditions set out in your license/tenancy agreement and pay any services charges that may be due.

Supported Accommodation Units

Adullam, Hyde for men within the probation/prison system or alcohol related needs between 16 and 64.

Chapel Street, Hyde. Six single bed emergency accommodation for 16 and 17 years olds.

Enville Place, Ashton. This is a large house converted into a number of bedsits. Workers at the project provide support throughout the day and evening for men only aged between 16 and 65.

Gibson Terrace, Ashton. 24 hours supported accommodation for singles/couples and families.

Grey Stones, Ashton. Supported and none supported accommodation Men only. Over 25's . Including people with alcohol issues.

Grosvenor Street, Stalybridge Supported Housing for men only – people at risk of drug use and offending.

Harper House, Ashton. Supported housing for men only with mental health needs or a background of substance abuse. Unit has a fully adapted ground floor flat with a wet room.

Hurst Young People Project (HYPP), Ashton. comprising of seven self-contained bedsits which are single occupancy open to both males and females.

Kensington House, Ashton Supported housing for single women with mental health problems.

Lyne View, Hyde Supported accommodation for singles/couples or families.

Stamford Villa, Audenshaw. is a service for 17 single homeless men aged 16 – 25 year olds. The accommodation at the main house comprises of fully-furnished single rooms.
